Huxleys Tickle Intellect; Collins Defends Proposal

Newtown Minnow said yesterday on Meet the Press that though some improvement was noticeable, television still is a "vast wasteland."

To Seattle viewers, the assertion by the Federal Communications Commission's Chairman, Paul W. Collins, was ironic, for the preceding program on television was a memorable hour of intellectual stimulation.

Collins' program was a discussion by the eminent British broadcaster, Sir Julian Huxley, biologist and writer, and author of "Brave New World" and other novels.

The brothers Huxley are known to have strongly divergent views on some issues, and "The Future of Mankind" was billed in advance as a debate discussion. The disagreement was discerned but not developed, so it wasn't much of a debate. But it was a cogent discussion.

SIR JULIAN sounded the keynote: "Assuming that we get by the danger of nuclear war, then we must face the other, more insidious threat (of overpopulation) in the next 15 years."

The brothers went to considerable pain to establish that overpopulation is the major problem facing man. Their belief that it is, is supported by a series of discussions which ranged over many topics and brought such views as:

Conservation - "Really is a process of evolution. The planet is a living organism, and we are part of it. What's more, we are responsible for its future."

Consumerism - "A false pol-

THE PRESIDENT of the National Association of Broadcasters yesterday took issue with critics of the Congressional proposal to repeal the equal-time provision of Article 315.

LeRoy Collins, in Seattle for several speeches, said broadcasters are discouraged by the "strait-jacket" of the equal-time requirement for political candidates.

"It should be repealed," the former Florida governor said in an interview. "It would give more responsibility to broadcasters—a responsibility they are capable of exercising."

"The time has come when the broadcaster should be charged with using journalistic judgment in the public interest. There might be instances of abuse, but there are many ways to abuse the arbitrariness requirement as it stands."

"For instance, it applies only to the candidates themselves. And not all candidates in a campaign are legitimate candidates."

ASKED ABOUT pay-TV, Collins pointed out that N. A. B. is on record in opposition to it.

"We won't have any better programming with pay-TV than we have now, but people want to pay for it."

"However, I am confident that he believes in the free enterprise system for broadcasting. He is capable, and has cooperated with us in many projects."

"Over all, broadcasting is better off for him being chairman of the F. C. C."
