Antennas Solve Stereo Problems

There is a component part of an FM stereo system which often is overlooked by the consumer (and which is of large significance in finer FM reception). Namely, the antenna.

As one broadcaster re-cently stated: "It's just as true today as it ever was that a component system is only as good as its weakest link. Component buyers are installing systems all the time containing an FM stereo receiver—and no FM antenna at all. Just as you lose the high frequencies if you install a \$3 cartridge in a fine component system. fine component system, you lose much of the benefit of a quality tuner if you do not include an antenna when you buy an FM set."

FM Radio to Surpass AM In 1970's, Study Predicts

FM radio will surpass AM the 1970's, says a report the Harvard Graduate by the Harvard Graude School of Business Adminis-

Harvard based its projection figures on Federal Communications Commission broadcast data and showed that the percentage of FM revenues to total radio advertising revenues will continue to grow at a 33 per cent rate — the percentage of 1956-61.

The Harvard study also took cognizance of the fact that there is a swift increase in the demand for FM receivers which fore-casts FM - set production overtaking AM-set making by 1968.

If the Harvard projections come true for United States production, American homes will be dominantly FM
